New Business.

Alderman Baird questioned why there were issues with the Public Works emergency phone during the recent below zero temperatures. Citizens said they could not get ahold of Public Works. The current phone tree requires too many options be taken instead of sending their calls directly to the emergency phone. Citizens told him they called the Police Department and Fire Department and they were not able to reach Public Works either.

Mr. Bodenhamer said the citizens did not let their water drip to prevent their pipes from freezing. Citizens then removed water meter covers letting freezing air reach the meter setters and they froze and busted. He stated there were no service lines busted and no major mains broken. He said he will have a discussion with the City's IT person about improving the phone tree.

Alderman Baird said he thinks the Public Works department did a great job as they received over 300 messages.
