## ALL RECYCLABLES MUST BE SORTED INTO THESE FIVE CATEGORIES

Listed are the recyclable material that is accepted at the Willard Recycling Center.

**ALUMINUM CANS:** Empty, preferably crushed or flattened.

**TIN CANS AND LIDS:** Up to one gallon. Rinse food cans. Remove labels and recycle with paper.

**PLASTIC:** Plastic containers up to one gallon that have a "1", "2", or "3" on or near the bottom. Examples include :

Milk jugs	Shampoo and hair conditioner bottles	Liquid laundry detergent containers
Soda and water bottles	Anti-freeze containers	Bleach bottles and jugs
Liquid dish-washing containers	Plastic fruit juice bottles	Liquid fabric softener containers
Mouthwash containers		Windshield solvent bottles

**PAPER:** Most paper products accepted. All paper is placed in one container at the recycling center and doesn't have to be sorted. Examples include:

Newspaper & Slick inserts	Computer paper	Colored paper
Telephone Books	Letterhead / Stationary	Construction paper
Books	Photocopy paper	Carbonless (NCR) paper
Magazines & Catalogs	Typing paper	Non metallic gift wrap
Bond paper	Scratch pads	Greeting cards
Calculator tape	Envelopes	Feed bags

The recycling center also accepts **pasteboard**. This is a "non-corrugated" cardboard such as:

Cereal boxes	Shoebboxes	paper towel
Macaroni and cheese boxes	Facial tissue boxes	toilet tissue pasteboard tubes etc.
Paper egg cartons	Greeting cards	

Remove any plastic or wax paper liner, flatten, and place in Paper Bin.

**All Paper must be clean and dry.**

**CORRUGATED CARDBOARD:** Flatten Boxes, tape and staples do not have to be removed.

**NO GLASS, LIQUIDS, CHEMICALS, TIRES, EXPLOSIVES, OR ANY HAZARDOUS WASTE ACCEPTED.**
